Joel 2:12-13 (NRSV) Yet even now, says the LORD, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; rend your hearts and not your clothing. Return to the LORD, your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love, and relents from punishing.

Wednesday, March 2, marks the beginning of our Lenten season. Historically, Lent has been a time of confession and repentance. It is a time where individuals and communities fast, pray, and lament the ways in which they have grieved God's heart. In the early church, Lent was also a time of restoration. Those who had been put out of the worshiping community because of their sin could make amends, show that they had changed, and be welcomed back into the faith community. For the early church, Lent was also a time when those who were new to the faith completed their three years of study and examination and prepared to be baptized and welcomed into the church during the Easter Vigil service.

In more recent history, we have focused mainly on individual confession and repentance. We "give up" something for Lent as a way of identifying with the sacrifice that Jesus made for us. Sometimes we "add" something, a spiritual discipline or act of service, as a way of drawing closer to God.

This Lent, I invite us all to not only consider our individual sins, but also our communal sins. Let us ask ourselves "how have we, as the church, failed to be the church that God calls us to be?" I also invite each of us to embrace this season as a time of restoration and reaffirmation of our faith. How do we need to be restored personally and communally? How do we, individually and as a church, need to reaffirm our faith? How can each of us study this season so that we enter into Holy Week and Easter renewed and recommitted to doing the work of God as individuals and as a church?

There will be different opportunities throughout the season of Lent for you to engage in study, worship, prayer, and conversation. I hope and I pray that each of us has a Holy and restorative Lenten season.
