Pastor's Message

I was reading a devotional a few days ago and the author said that we should "rise with joy" every day. He was not speaking of the resurrection, but a daily attitude that we should assume when waking in the morning. I know that some people are "morning people." They bounce out of bed with the rising of the sun, happy to be up and wide awake. Some like the morning but need a cup of coffee or two before finding their cheerful selves. Others would rather have morning happen a little later in the day.

The point of the devotional wasn't that we should love mornings, but that we should begin each day with joy, giving thanks to God for the day and for the possibilities that the day holds. What would it be like to start each day with joy? Joy can be hard, especially if we are grieving, hurting, or struggling. However, each of us can begin the day with a "thank-you" to God for giving us the day as a gift to be used for God's purposes. We can begin each day asking God to let us be a blessing to one person that day. We can begin each day with the joy of knowing that no matter what is going on in our lives, God is with us.

This month I invite you to practice rising with joy every day. Give thanks to God, know that the day before you is a gift, and seek the joy that only God can bring.

Our leadership Team is in the process of ordering a new electronic sign for the front lawn of our church. (The space for the sign, in line with the garden gate, is marked in white paint on the grass if you are curious about the location. The sign will be set back enough to ensure visibility of traffic.)

Before the Christmas season, we hope to have installed our new double-sided, full color TEKstar Outdoor LED sign. You can see a sample of what the sign will look like on the flyer in the walkway. The sign is 6' wide by 4' high on a pedestal 2' high. It has an active display case 2'1" X 5'3" and can display 3 lines of changeable lettering and graphics. Communication to the sign is provided by short-range wireless radios. An electrician is being hired to get the electrical wiring out to the sign location, which will require some trench digging.

Our membership has always supported our special project needs with their prayers and their generous gifts. More than 3/4 of the funding for the sign is being provided from Trustees and Memorial Gift funds. We encourage our members to help us pay for the sign by donating to the Improvement Fund or donating in memory of loved ones.
